UK Masters 2024 Season Tournament Pack

Ruleset

UK Masters is an invitation only, five game 3rd Edition Kings of War Tournament. Games will be played using the Kings of War 3rd Ed Compendium rulebook 2022, the current mantic FAQ document, and the Clash of Kings supplement rulebook **released** in October 2024 (i.e. clash 2025).

All armies listed in the Mantic Companion will be permitted, restrictions on composition are contained in the Event Rules Section of this pack.

Schedule and timing

The event will comprise 5 games of Kings of War 3rd edition.

Each game will be timed with a time limit of 60 mins per person permitted. Players will need to provide a chess clock between them for each game.

Games are scheduled as below. Please endeavour to be as prompt as you can be to ensure that the day runs to plan.

In the event of a players timing out the “dice down” approach will be used. The player that has run out of time will roll no further dice, move no units etc but will not lose the game by default. Objectives, table sectors and loot tokens will still be scored. Their opponent may continue to play their full turn allocation including playing out a turn 7 if one becomes available.

Tickets

Tickets will be by invite only. Attendees will be contacted individually. Price will be £45

Army lists

Armies must be to the value of 2,300 points and created using the Kings of War 3rd Ed Compendium rulebook 2022, the current mantic FAQ document, and the Clash of Kings supplement rulebook **released** in October 2024 (i.e. clash 2025). They must be constructed using Mantic Companion and submitted using the following tournament code: **EviXNdBsTP**

Allies are not permitted. The optional withdraw rule will not be used. Command dice will not be used.

Lists must be submitted by **23:59 on Saturday 11 January 2025**.

Gaming

To take part you require the following:

- Your fully painted 2,300-point army, mounted on correct-sized unit bases
- At least two printed copies of your army list for you and your opponents
- Rule book, tape-measure, dice, damage markers, pencils, and other gaming paraphernalia
- A chess clock, stop-watch, phone, or other similar time-tracking device
- We recommend that you bring a large tray to carry your army between games
- It is highly recommended that you bring a smart phone with the Mantic companion installed for reporting of results and viewing matchups.

Please bring dice that are clear to read for both you and your opponents. Any custom dice may only have a symbol on one facing. For example, you may use dice that have your team logo on one facing, but all other faces must have standard dice pips. You may not also have another symbol on another face.

We will provide all the tables and scenery for the event. These will be setup for you before Game One. Terrain maps will be provided and the terrain must be set up according to each round's map before each game. If you feel this is not possible, please contact a TO who will assist you.

Scoring

The tournament will be using the Blackjack Scoring System.

Tournament Points (TPs)

The amount of Tournament Points (TPs) you have scored in your game is calculated using three criteria:

Result Points

Win	Draw	Loss
14	10	7

Scenario Points (SP)

Generally, this will be based on the difference between the Victory Points as per each scenario. This will adjust the TPs up or down according to the difference and will be up to and including +/-4 TPs.

Attrition Points

This will adjust the TPs up or down based on the points difference between your opponent's army routed and your army routed, as per the table below:

0-280	281-900	901-1700	1701+
0/0	+1/-1	+2/-2	+3/-3

Submitting results

Players will submit their Result, Scenario Points, and Points Routed via the Mantic Companion app (or via paper if you don't have a phone) and the score calculation will be done automatically. Your total score for the round is calculated by adding these three point scores together, with a max score of 21 and a minimum score of 0.

When calculating placings, the order of decider will be:

Tournament Points; Scenario Points; Points Routed; Scenario Points Attrition; Routed Attrition; Strength of Schedule

Disputes

In the event that there is a situation that the players cannot decide between them the opinion of the TO shall be final (even if later proven to be wrong).

Awards and Prizes

Trophies will be awarded for First, Second and Third placed battle scores, the wooden spoon for last place and Best Army.

Sportsmanship

Players are expected to conduct themselves well and the focus should be on a good, clean game. Specific concerns should be referred to the TO. In the event a player is deemed to be acting in a manner not befitting the game, their scores will all be marked to zero, and their opponents' to 21.

Tie Breaks

Any tie breaks will be decided on by the TO.

This tournament pack is subject to change up to 1 week prior to the army submission deadline, in terms of scoring system, FAQ version in effect and other ancillary details.

Army composition rules will remain unchanged.

Scenarios and Maps

The scenarios and maps have been pre-set by the non-playing members of the masters committee, and will be released one week prior to the event. .
